We will also have weekly spelling words this year. Please help your child practice spelling these words at home. The last three words on this list of spelling words will be in italics. These are “challenge words.” These words may require a little extra work in order for your child to learn them.

This week we will be reading a story called “Iris and Walter.” It is about a little girl named Iris who moves to the country. It is a good story about being in a new place and making new friends-perfect for the beginning of a new school year!
